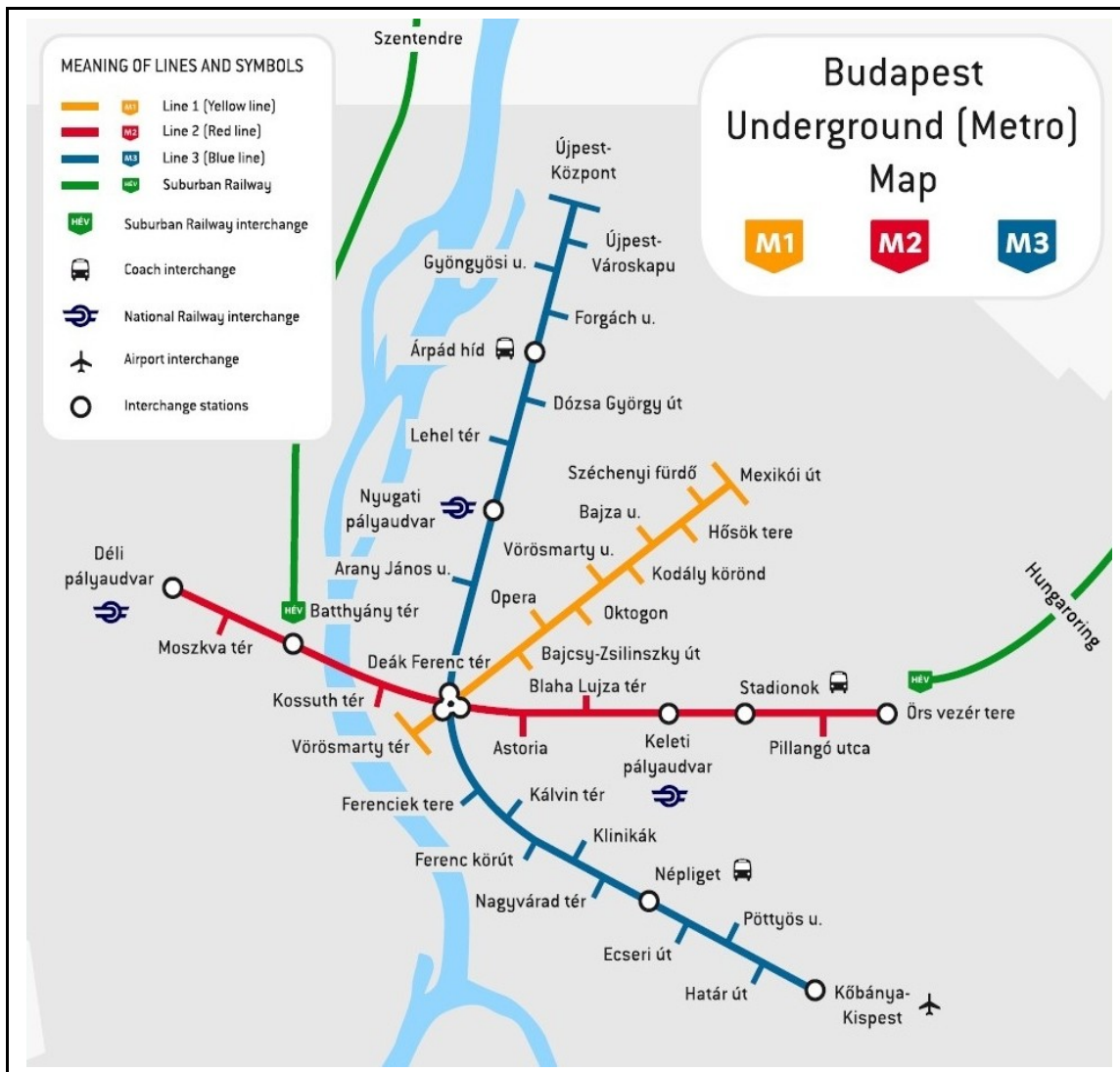
How to get to the hotel?

From the airport:

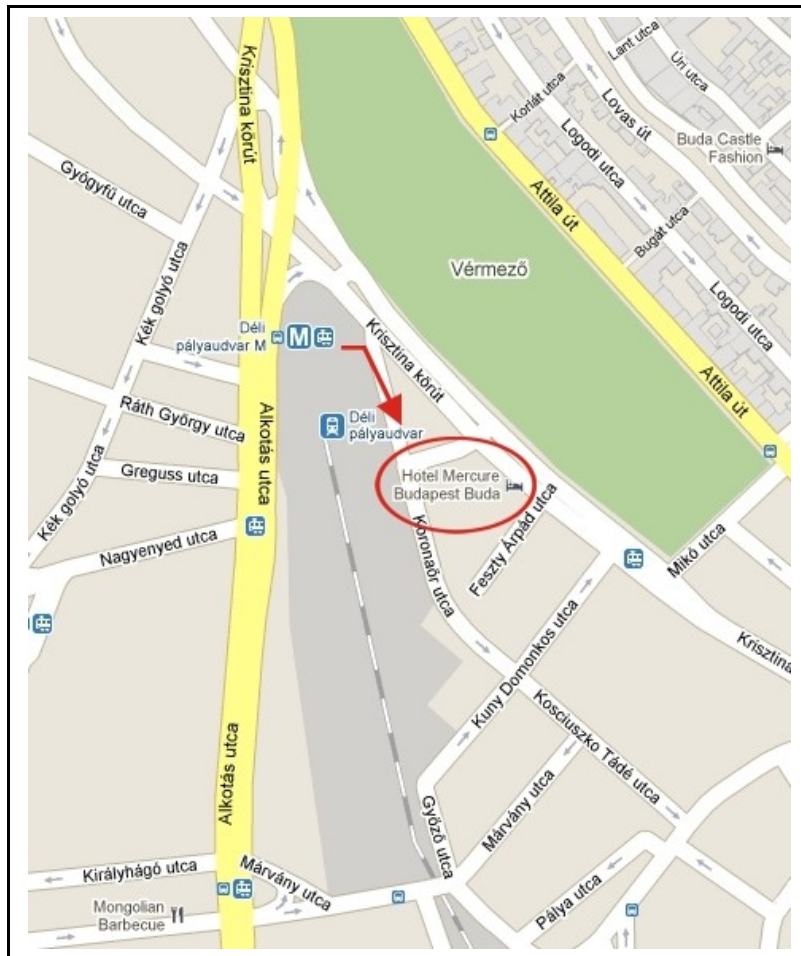
- **By public transport (≈2EUR):** From the airport the bus No. 200E drives to the terminus of the blue metro line "Kőbánya-Kispest" (you can buy tickets on the bus from the driver). By the metro you should travel to the station "Deák Ferenc tér". With the same metro ticket you can change to the red metro line into direction "Déli pályaudvar" (or in short form "Déli pu.") and you should go to the end station. - **By AirportShuttle-Minibus (≈12EUR):** Minibus is comfortable door-to-door transfer to the city and it is cheaper than any taxi company. You can reserve it, but it is not necessary. The AirportShuttle-Minibus desks are to be found at every terminal. For more information see the homepage: http://www.bud.hu/english/transport/airport_shuttle

From railway station:

There are three main railway stations at Budapest. South railway station "Déli pályaudvar" is very close to the Hotel. From other railway stations you can reach the hotel by metro, which is the cheapest and fastest way. From East railway station "Keleti pályaudvar" you should take the red metro line to "Déli pályaudvar". From the West railway station "Nyugati pályaudvar" you should take the blue metro line to the station "Deák Ferenc tér". There you can change to the red metro line with the same ticket into direction "Déli pályaudvar" and go to the end station. See the following Metro line map for better orientation.



At the terminus "Déli pályaudvar" of the red metro line there is Hotel Mercure Budapest Buda. As you go out from the metro station you should turn left. As you go out from the building on the street - you should turn right and after 100-200 meter there is the hotel. The location is Krisztina krt. 41/43 (second building from the station). Public transfer to the Hungarian academy of Science:

Take the red metro line from "Déli pályaudvar" to "Kossuth tér" and walk along the street "Alkotmány utca". See the following map. If you don't want to walk, you can take the tram No. 2. The tram stop is located in front of the metro building. You have to take the tram to the next stopping place in the left direction.



Walk to the Hungarian Academy of Science:

It is also possible to take a longer walk straight from the hotel through the beautiful Buda Castle and the "Lánchíd" bridge. See the following map. The tour takes about 30 minutes.
